REQUIREMENTS

Base Score

(Complete all 4 measures for 50 points, must have at least 1 in the numerator)



Protect Patient Health Information



Provide Patient Access


Health Information Exchange

Performance Score

(Select measures that best fit your practice for an additional 90 points)




Health Information Exchange (up to 20 pts)
Immunization Registry Reporting (up to 10 pts)
Medication Reconciliation (up to 10 pts)
Patient-Specific Education (up to 10 pts)
Provide Patient Access (up to 20 pts)
Secure Messaging (up to 10 pts)
View, Download & Transmit (VDT) (up to 10 pts)



Bonus Points

Public Health Registry Reporting – 5% Bonus

One CPIA - 10% Bonus



E-Prescribing

ECs who achieve 100 points or greater will receive the full 25 points towards their composite score

SCORING Max 100 points

If objectives and measures are *not* applicable to an EC, CMS will reweight the category to zero and assign the 25% to the Quality performance category

Hospital-based MIPS ECs may choose to report under the ACI Performance Category

NPs, PAs, CNSs and CSAs also have the option to report on ACI measures for the first year. If they choose not to then the 25% goes to the Quality performance category

If an EC faces a significant hardship and are unable to report ACI measures, they can apply to have their performance category score weighted to zero




Attestation, QCDR, Qualified Registry or EHR
